The following agreement must be signed by the student's parent or guardian.

Chinese School Administration Rules for Students During School Hours (1:00 PM to 4:30 PM)

1. No running, screaming, yelling, or any other obnoxious behavior down the hallways.
2. No playing with the lights, water or any other equipment in the classrooms or hallways.
3. Food and drink may not be brought into the classrooms without permission.
4. All students have to follow the teachers' directions. Students must raise their hands before speaking.
5. All students have to complete all class work and homework assignments assigned by their teachers.

Failure to comply with these rules will result in serious consequences and possibly expulsion.

- I. If a student misbehaves a first time, the student will receive a warning before the parents of the student will be contacted.
- II. If a student misbehaves a second time, a referral will be issued, the parents of the student will be contacted, and a parent will be required to stay with the student during the school hours.
- III. If a student misbehaves a third time, a referral will be sent home. A student acquiring three referrals in a semester will be **expelled from the school for the rest of the semester.**

Depending on the severity of the student's misbehavior, the school reserves the right to expel the student from the school with or without warnings in advance.

My child and I have read and are informed of the rules and enforcement set by the Tampa Bay Chinese School Administration listed above. I understand that all regulations will go into effect immediately upon my signing of this document.
