Course Description:

This course is intended for American born kids to learn Chinese. Daily used Chinese characters, words, expressions, sentence patterns will be taught in the class. It includes reading, writing (the order and count of each character's writing stroke.), and speaking (1.pronouncing Chinese characters, words and expressions 2.use the daily sentence pattern to express themselves). Chinese culture will be integrated to target language learning.

Course Objectives:

At the end of the course, students should be able to:

- 1. read, write and pronounce over 70 new words in Chinese.
- 2. read, write and explain someone use something to do something in Chinese.
- 3. read, write, ask question "Will ...?", "Why...?" and make answers in Chinese.
- 4. read, write and express someone will to do something in Chinese.
- 5. read, write and use sentence pattern"cong...dao..." in Chinese.
- 6. read, write and express someone want to do something in Chinese.
- 7. Culture: Chinese Zodiac, Chinese New Year.

Teaching Strategy:

Chinese is the main language used in the classroom. English translation will be provided wherever needed. Chinese songs, poems, and stories will be added to make classes more interesting and to introduce Chinese culture to kids. Chinese culture will be integrated to target language learning. Varity of activities (think-and-pair, white board, in and out ...) will be used in the classroom to enhance the learning.
